Fort Vancouver fireworks 50th celebration!

This year, Vancouver celebrates the 50th Anniversary of Independence Day at Fort Vancouver, a beloved community event. This celebration of our nation's independence is the largest event in the City of Vancouver with more than 30,000 attendees.

The celebration is sponsored by the Fort Vancouver National Trust and features a patriotic parade, a great entertainment line-up on the main stage, a heritage stage, activities and games for children, and, of course, a phenomenal fireworks show. Our community values and sustains this event as our own - each year, more than 300 volunteers make the event possible.

The celebration began as a one-day party centered on a large, single music performance stage, culminating with a fireworks show. Over time, it has evolved into a family-focused event with an array of activities for all ages to celebrate our nation's Independence. It has become an iconic Vancouver event, so come celebrate at Fort Vancouver as we hit the half-century mark!

Vancouver: an emerging paradise for beer enthusiasts

The closure of Lucky Lager in 1985 left Vancouver and Clark County without a brewery for the first time since Prohibition. It wasn't until the 1990s that the craft beer scene started to re-emerge in Vancouver.

In fall 2011, the local market exploded with the opening of Mt Tabor Brewery, and in 2012, by Loowit Brewing Co., Heathen

Brewing, West Highland Brewing, Railside Brewing (Washougal) and Ghost Runner Brewery. Add those to the established McMenamins on the Columbia, Old Ivy Taproom at the Salmon Creek Brewery & Pub, and Laurelwood Brewing Co. in Battle Ground and we had ten businesses brewing beer in Clark County.

Local craft brewers are being showcased at all five of the beer festivals taking place this year in Vancouver. With more breweries entering the local scene, like Amnesia Brewing, Mill Creek Brew Werks, and Dirty Hands Brewing, it's clear that Vancouver is an emerging force in the craft beer industry.
